PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (BHACHAU, GUJARAT)



nder the project, 49 free health check-up camps were conducted during the month of September 2022, benefiting 1844 patients and in the month of October 2022, 42 camps with 1520 beneficiaries were conducted. A PHDFWF-Jaquar mobile medical van has been providing health care services in 11 adopted villages of Jaquar in Bhachau, Gujarat, including free diagnostic care and medicine distribution

PHDFWF-JAQUAR-ROTARY PREMIER MOBILE MEDICAL VAN

HDFWF-Jaguar Foundation-Rotary Premier. Mobile has delivering free health services to children to improve their health conditions. A total of 1351 children were examined by conducting 21 free health check-up camps in the month of September and 17 free health check-up camps were conducted that benefitted 1040 patients in the month of October 2002 under the project. PHDFWF and the Department of Women and Child Development, Government of NCT Delhi, have been very committed to the abandoned children living in 101 children's homes of Delhi.





PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION DENTAL AND EYE MOBILE VAN



PHDFWF-Jaquar Eye & Dental mobile medical van has been taking care of needy patients by organizing free eye and dental check-up camps including dental screening, scaling and filling, diagnostic treatment, free medications, spectacles, etc. under the project. A total of 1110 local patients were diagnosed by 21 free eye and dental camps in the month of September 2022 and 1005 patients benefitted in 20 camps during the month of October 2022.

PHDFWF- TARGET INTERVENTION PROJECT ON HIV/AIDS

HDFWF has been delivering healthcare and RCH services to the HRGs and the migrant workers living in resettlement areas of Okhla through the Target Intervention Project (TI) with the support from Delhi State AIDs Control Society (DSACS), Govt of NCT of Delhi since 2003. During the month of September 2022, 273 ICTC, 30 PT, 6-STI, 4 review meetings, 2 DIC, 7 demand generation meetings, 1 advocacy meeting, 425 RMC, etc., were conducted under the project which benefited 464 patients. In the month of October



2022, 235 ICTC, 32 PT, 6 STI, 5 review meetings, 3 DIC, 10 demand generation meetings, 452 RMC, etc.,

were conducted under the project that benefited 490 patients who availed the free clinical services at the TI Centre Okhla.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (BHIWADI, RAJASTHAN).



A total of 1071 patients were screened free of charge in 19 health check-ups held in five adopted villages of Jaquar in Bhiwadi, Rajasthan, in September 2022 and 419 patients were screened free of charge in 9 health check-ups in the month of October 2022. Patients were being provided with free healthcare services, medication, diagnostic care, etc under the project.

PHDFWF-SMPF MOBILE MEDICAL VAN



uring the month of September 2022, 1050 local patients availed free health care service through 20 free health check-up camps in the resettlement areas of Delhi/NCR. A total of 995 patients received free health care through 16 camps in the month of October 2022. PHDFWF-SMPF mobile medical van has been providing diagnostic facilities, doctor consultations, medical tests and medicines to disadvantaged communities under the project.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (GURUGRAM, HARYANA)



During the month of September 2022, 20 free health check-up camps were carried out that benefitted 1471 beneficiaries and 17 free health check-up camps were carried out that benefitted 1050 beneficiaries in the month of October 2022, under the project. PHDFWF-Jaquar mobile medical van has been running with the purpose to serve the needy communities living in the remote villages of Harchandpur, Alipur, Garhi Bazidpur and Dhaula in Gurugram.

PHDFWF-AAOT MOBILE MEDICAL VAN

PhDFWF-AAOT mobile medical van in association with Holy Family Hospital have been serving the poor communities by conducting free health check-up camps for 890 patients through 18 health check-up camps in the month of September 2022 and 780 patients through 16 health check-up camps in the month of October 2022 at Subhash Camp, Naibasti, Taimoor Nagar, Ali village Priyanka, Camp, New Delhi.
