PROGRAMME SHOWCASING SHORT FILM INTEGRAL INDIA





HEALTH CARE

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (BHACHAU, GUJARAT)



PHDFWF-Jaquer mobile medical van has been serving the marginalized villagers by facilitating free healthcare services including free diagnostic care and medicine distribution in 11 adopted villages of Jaquer in Bhachau, Gujarat. During the month of August 2022, 44 free health checkup camps were conducted and benefitted 1450 patients under the project.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION DENTAL AND EYE MOBILE VAN



Atotal of 18 free eye and dental camps were carried out and served 784 patients in the month of August 2022. PHDFWF-Jaquer Eye & Dental mobile medical van has been providing free eye and dental check-ups, dental screening, scaling and filling, diagnostic treatment and free medications and spectacles etc. to the local patients under the project.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR-ROTARY PREMIER MOBILE MEDICAL VAN



PHDFWF and Department of Women and Child Development, Government of NCT Delhi, has been majorly focusing on the good health of children living in tot children's' homes of Delhi. PHDFWF-Jaquaar Foundation-Rotary Premier Mobile Medical Van has been conducting free health check-up camps for deprived children to make them healthy and happy. During the month of August 2022, 980 children were being diagnosed by 10 free health check-up camps under the project.

PHDFWF-SMPF MOBILE MEDICAL VAN



PHDFWF- SMPF mobile medical van has been delivering free healthcare services, diagnostic care, clinical tests and medicines to the marginalized sections of the society under the project. During the month of August 2022, 1329 patients availed free treatment through 18 free health check-up camps in the resettlement areas of Delhi/NCR.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (BHIWADI, RAJASTHAN).

Under the project, Patients are availing free healthcare services including free medicines, diagnostic care and OPD facilities. During the month of August 2022, 1200 patients were benefitted by 21 free health check-up camps in five adopted villages of Jaquaar in Bhiwadi, Rajasthan.



PHDFWF-AAOT MOBILE MEDICAL VAN

PHDFWF-AAOT mobile medical van in association with Holy Family Hospital have been serving the poor communities by conducting free health check-up camps for 744 patients through 16 health checkup camps in Subhash Camp, Naibasti, Taimoor Nagar, Ali village Priyanka, Camp, New Delhi in the month of August 2022.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (GURUGRAM, HARYANA)



During the month of August 2022, 18 free health check-up camps were conducted that benefitted 1350 beneficiaries under the project. PHDFWF-Jaqua mobile medical van has been running with the purpose to serve the needy communities living in the remote villages of Harchandpur, Alipur, Garhi Basidpur and Daula in Gurugram.

PHDFWF- TARGET INTERVENTION PROJECT ON HIV/AIDS



During the month of August 2022, 265-HCTC, 22-PT, 9-STI, 4-review meetings, 2-DNC, 6 demand generation meetings, 4 review meetings, 1 advocacy meeting, 419 RMC etc., were conducted under the project. A total of 465 patients availed the free clinical services in the TI centre Okhla. PHDFWF has been serving the local communities by its healthcare and RCH services to the HRGs and the migrant workers in resettlement areas of Okhla through the Target Intervention Project (TI) with the support from Delhi State AIDS Control Society (DSACS), Govt. of NCT Delhi since 2009.

SKILL & VOCATIONAL TRAINING

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRES, MANDI VILLAGE



PHDFWF-Jaqua Foundation training development center has a vision to enhance the required skills of the beneficiaries and give them a livelihood support through the free skill development training on beauty culture, tailoring, mobile repairing and cooking to the youth and women of Mandi village. Presently, 95 trainees are continuing their learning under the project.



PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, MATALWAS



PHDFWF has been enhancing the vocational skills training for underprivileged women and youth in Matalwas, Rajasthan. In August 2022, 179 rural women and youth attended their regular classes on beauty culture, tailoring and embroidery, maths & science tutorial and computer education under the project.

L&T PRAYAS SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, PALLA, FARIDABAD

During the month of August 2022, 75 local women and youth availed free classes on computer, tailoring, and embroidery courses at the centre with the support from L&T Prayas Trust.



PHDFWF - JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRES, SIKRA, GUJARAT

With the support from Jaquar Foundation, PHDFWF is providing opportunities to the needy women & youth to sharpen their skills under the project of skill development courses in Sikra, Gujarat. About 83 local women and youth availed training on beauty culture, tailoring, and computer education in August 2022.

PHDFWF-HSIL SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, TEHKHAND, OKHLA



PHDFWF- HSIL skill development center is providing livelihood support training to the local women and youth in Tehkhand village, Okhla. About 74 local women and youth availed the trainings on computer education, tailoring and beauty culture during the month of August 2022.

PHDFWF - JAQUAR - SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTER-1 IN KHAROI, BHACHAU, KUTCH GUJARAT



PHDFWF with the support from Jaquar Foundation has been providing skill development trainings for the local people living in Kharoi, Bhachau, Kutch, Gujarat. A total of 128 beneficiaries benefited from the project by engaging themselves in the free courses in computer education, beauty culture, tailoring, and local craft in August 2022.

PHDFWF - SMPF SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, DWARKAPURI



PHDFWF and SMPF are promoting the vocational skills of local women & youth through the skill development project in Dwarkapuri. 119 trainees learnt tailoring and embroidery, beauty culture, mobile repairing, and computer education during the month of August 2022. Beneficiaries are getting benefits of other development activities under the project.

PHDFWF - JAQUAR - SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTER-2 IN KHAROI, BHACHAU, KUTCH GUJARAT

With support of Jaquar Foundation, PHDFWF is expanding the welfare activities by providing skill trainings to the local women & youth in Kharoi, Kutch, Gujarat. About 33 women and youth availed mobile repairing and tutorial classes on math and science classes during August 2022.



PHDFWF-ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI PREMIER- SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, BHALSWA DAIRY, SWAROOP NAGAR, DELHI



PHDFWF-Rotary Club of Delhi Premier skill development training center is providing training to local women and youth living in Bhalswa Dairy at Swaroop Nagar, Delhi. About 104 trainees availed free training on computer education, beauty culture, and tailoring during the month of August 2022. Health check-up camps, awareness programme, observation of special days etc. are also being organized under the project.

PHDFWF - JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRES, BHACHAU, GUJARAT



In August 2022, 187 trainees availed training courses on Beauty Culture, Computer Education, Tailoring, tutorial in Math and Science, and local craft under this project. PHDFWF with support from Jaquar Foundation have been providing skill development trainings to the needy women and youth in Bhachau, Gujarat.

PHDFWF- GOYAL MG GASES – MOBIUS FOUNDATION SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, BADLI EXTN, ROHINI



PHDFWF Goyal MG Gases-Mobius Foundation skill development training centre is providing skill enhancement courses to the local women & youth for their career growth and income generation. About 106 beneficiaries availed skills and knowledge of computer education, tailoring, and beauty culture training.

PHDFWF - JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, NARAYAN VIHAR, RAJASTHAN



PHDFWF - Jaquar Foundation have been running the skill development project for the betterment of rural women and youth. Presently, 172 women and girls are enhancing their livelihood support skills on computer education, science and math tutorial courses, beauty culture and tailoring during the month of August, 2022 in the centre of Narayan Vihar, Rajasthan.

PHDFWF - N. L. MEHRA VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE, AYA NAGAR



Under the project, 150 trainees are obtaining free training in retail management, advanced computer education, electrician, nursing assistant and beauty culture with the support from Jaquar Foundation. PHDFWF- N. L. Mehra Vocational Training Centre has been focusing on the vocational skills development of the local women and youth of Ayanagar.

PHDFWF-WRG SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, AYA NAGAR

PHDFWF with the support of Women Rehabilitation Group, USA, is developing the skills of local women and youth. Presently, 73 local women and youth are undergoing training of computer education, tailoring, and embroidery at the PHDFWF-WRG centre in Aya Nagar. Other project-related activities are also taking place concurrently.



PHDFWF SKILL CENTRE FOR AFTERCARE CHILDREN LIVING IN CCI, LAJPAT NAGAR

PHDFWF and the Ministry of Women and Children, Govt. of NCT Delhi, are supporting and strengthening the abilities of needy children by providing free computer education training to children living in child care institutions of Lajpat Nagar. Trainees were also involved in other awareness-raising activities in the month of August 2022.
