SKILL DEVELOPMENT & VOCATIONAL TRAINING

PHDFWF SKILL CENTRE FOR AFTERCARE CHILDREN, LAJPAT NAGAR





PHDFWF, in collaboration with the Ministry of Women and Children, Government of NCT Delhi, is committed to supporting disadvantaged children through the provision of computer education. The aim is to improve their career opportunities and boost their earning potential. As of November 2023, a total of 20 children from child care institutions in Lajpat Nagar are currently enrolled in and benefiting from this training initiative.

PHDWF-VIDYA JYOTI SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, MEHRAULI



With the support of Vidya Jyoti initiative, PHDFWF is actively bolstering the skills of women and young individuals in the neighbouring community. Currently, the PHDFWF-Vidya Jyoti centre in Mehrauli is delivering computer education to a group of 40 women and youth. This training program continues throughout the month of November.

PHDFWF- HINDUSTAN TIN WORKS SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, PUL PEHLADPUR



With financial backing from Hindustan Tin Works Ltd, PHDFWF is empowering recipients with skill development, focusing on promoting financial stability and self-sufficiency. In November 2023, a sum of 75 individuals is actively participating in acquiring expertise in tailoring and beauty culture as part of this endeavour.

PHDFWF-L & T PRAYAS REMEDIAL CLASSES CENTRE, TEHKHAND, OKHLA



The PHDFWF-L&T Prayas Remedial Classes center is offering crucial assistance to underprivileged students in grades 9 to 11 who face challenges accessing private tutoring. Presently, during the month of November, a collective of 70 girls and young individuals are actively involved in the ongoing remedial classes of the project.

PHDFWF- N.L MEHRA VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE, AYA NAGAR




The N. L. Mehra Vocational Training Centre is presently providing no-cost skill development programs encompassing diverse fields like retail management, advanced computer education, electrician training, nursing assistant courses, and beauty culture. As of November 2023, 150 individuals are availing themselves of these cost-free training opportunities.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, KASIABEDA, BADAMPAHAR, ODISHA



As part of this program, PHDFWF-Jaquar Foundation is actively involved in enhancing the skills of women and youth in the nearby community. Presently, 104 participants are actively taking part in the initiative, engaging in training sessions that concentrate on tailoring and computer education.

PHDFWF- GOYAL MG GASES-MOBIUS FOUNDATION SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, BADLI EXTN, ROHINI



In November 2023, 106 people underwent diverse skill development programs, including computer education, tailoring, and beauty culture, at the PHDFWF Goyal MG Gases-Mobius Foundation Skill Development Training Center. The center is committed to enhancing the skills of the local community, especially emphasizing the empowerment of women and girls. Moreover, supplementary project-related initiatives have been organized to further support the participants of the program.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, TEHKHAND, OKHLA



The PHDFWF-JAQUAR Skill Development Center is positively influencing the women and youth of Tehkhand Village, Okhla, by providing them with essential skills such as computer education, tailoring, and beauty culture. As of November 2023, 120 local women and young individuals are actively engaged in these training programs under the project.

PHDWF-WRG SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, MEHRAULI



With support from the Women Rehabilitation Group in the USA, PHDFWF is strengthening the vocational skills of women and youth in the nearby community. Currently, 35 women and young individuals are undergoing training in tailoring and embroidery at the PHDFWF-WRG center situated in Mehrauli.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, HATBADRA, ODISHA



The PHDFWF-Jaquar Foundation is dedicated to improving the skills of women and youth in the local community through an ongoing project. Currently, 94 participants are actively involved, receiving comprehensive training in both tailoring and computer education. This initiative continues with planned activities throughout the month of November.

PHDFWF-KAJARIA CERAMICS SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, ASSAM



Supported by Kajaria Ceramics Ltd, PHDFWF has been offering assistance to underprivileged women and girls in the Lakhimpur district of Assam through the establishment of a skill development center. The hand weaving training center is situated in Borimudi village, while the knitting training center is located in Dhenudharia, both within the Lakhimpur district of Assam. This

initiative is empowering numerous girls and women, providing them with the means to attain financial independence.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRES, ALIPUR, GURUGRAM



The collaborative effort of PHDFWF and Jaquar Foundation is actively fostering the incomegenerating abilities of women and young individuals in the local community through their ongoing project. Currently, 78 participants are actively engaged in project activities, undergoing training in beauty culture, tailoring, and computer education. This initiative extends into the month of November.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, ASSAM



The Jaquar Foundation is presently supporting women from the nearby community in improving their income-generating skills. Launched in May 2023, the project involves 85 participants actively engaged in learning hand weaving and tailoring to broaden their opportunities for earning.

PHDFWF-SMPF SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, DWARKAPURI



Supported by SMPF, PHDFWF is expanding fundamental knowledge and skills through a skill development initiative based in Dwarkapuri. Currently, 119 participants are engaged in training programs covering tailoring and embroidery, beauty culture, mobile repair, and computer education in November 2023. In addition to these activities, beneficiaries are benefiting from various other development programs provided as part of this initiative.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, MATALWAS



PHDFWF, in collaboration with the Jaquar Foundation, is currently strengthening the skill sets of rural women and youth to improve their livelihood opportunities. In Matalwas, Rajasthan, 179 individuals are currently undergoing free training in beauty culture, tailoring, embroidery, math and science tutorials, and computer education through this project. This program is ongoing, with activities continuing throughout the month of November.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRES, MANDI VILLAGE



The PHDFWF-Jaquar Foundation is proactively fostering the skills of women and youth in the nearby community through its continuous project. In November 2023, 180 participants in Mandi village are actively involved in project activities, undergoing training in beauty culture, tailoring, mobile repair, remedial education, computer education, and culinary skills.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR-SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTER IN KHAROI, KUTCH GUJARAT



In November 2023, a total of 128 individuals are undergoing skill-based training in computer education, beauty culture, tailoring, and local craft. PHDFWF, with the backing of the Jaquar Foundation, is conducting skill development programs for the residents of Kharoi, Kutch, Gujarat. The distribution of certificates took place in the esteemed presence of Shri Shamsher Kanwar, CSR Head of Jaquar Foundation, and the Secretariat of PHDFWF.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, BHACHAU, GUJARAT



The Jaquar Foundation and PHDFWF have partnered to support skill development initiatives, delivering crucial skills training to disadvantaged women and youth in Bhachau, Gujarat. In November 2023, a collective of 187 trainees is actively gaining skills free of charge in Beauty Culture, Tailoring, local crafts, Computer Education, and participating in tutorial classes for math and science as part of this program.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, NARAYAN VIHAR, RAJASTHAN



In partnership with the Jaquar Foundation, PHDFWF is currently delivering skill development training to women and youth in the local community. At the Narayan Vihar center in Rajasthan, 172 women and girls are actively engaging in training programs encompassing computer education, science and math tutorials, beauty culture, and tailoring.

PHDFWF-VSF SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, NOIDA



Thanks to the generous backing of the Vivek & Smita Foundation, PHDFWF manages a skill development training center in Noida. This facility provides instruction in mobile repair and tailoring, and currently, 65 students are actively taking advantage of the training opportunities it offers.

PHDFWF- PRAYAS TRUST, FARIDABAD, SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTER, MEETHAPUR, DWARKA.



With support from Prayas Trust in Faridabad, PHDFWF manages a skill development training center in Meethapur. Currently, the center is providing training for 120 students in areas such as tailoring, computer education, mobile repair, and beauty education. Bridal Makeup done by beneficiaries.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING CENTRE, SAMAKHYALI, GUJARAT



PHDFWF, collaborating with the Jaquar Foundation, has launched a new initiative for skill development in Samakhyali, Gujarat. Currently, 160 participants have enrolled in the program and are actively engaging in complimentary training sessions focused on Beauty Culture, Tailoring, and Computer Education. This training program is ongoing throughout the entire month of November.

HEALTH CARE

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (GURUGRAM, HARYANA)



During November 2023, a total of 17 free health check-up events were conducted, benefiting 1234 individuals as part of the initiative. The PHDFWF-Jaquar mobile medical van continued its operations with the aim of providing essential healthcare services to underserved communities

residing in remote areas, specifically in the villages of Harchandpur, Alipur, Garhi Bazidpur, and Dhaula located in Gurugram.

PHDFWF- IAI MOBILE MEDICAL VAN



In November 2023, 10 health check-up events were conducted, resulting in the provision of free diagnostic care and distribution of medicines to 1280 individuals. The PHDFWF-IAI mobile medical van has been actively delivering healthcare services to various villages in Faridabad, Haryana.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (BHACHAU, GUJARAT)



Under the project, 42 free health check-up camps were conducted in the month of November 2023, benefited 1582 patients. The PHDFWF-Jaquar mobile medical van has been providing health care services in 11 adopted villages of Jaquar in Bhachau, Gujarat, including free diagnostic care and medicine distribution.

PHDFWF-AAOT MOBILE MEDICAL VAN

PHDFWF-AAOT mobile medical van in association with Holy Family Hospital have been serving the poor communities by conducting free health check-up camps for 902 patients through 23 health check-up camps in the month of November 2023 at Subhash Camp, Naibasti, Taimoor Nagar, Ali village, Priyanka Camp, New Delhi.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION DENTAL AND EYE MOBILE VAN



PHDFWF-Jaquar Eye & Dental mobile medical van has been taking care of needy patients by organising free eye and dental check-up camps including dental screening, scaling and filling, diagnostic treatment, free medications, spectacles, etc. under the project. A total of 1160 patients were diagnosed by 17 free eye and dental camps in the month of November 2023.

PHDFWF- TARGET INTERVENTION PROJECT ON HIV/AIDS

PHDFWF has been delivering healthcare and RCH services to the HRGs and the migrant workers living in resettlement areas of Okhla through the Target Intervention Project (TI) with the support from Delhi State AIDs Control Society (DSACS), Govt. of NCT Delhi since 2003. During the month of November 2023, 190- ICTC, 5-STI, 4- review meeting, 3-DIC, 486 RMC, 54 PT, 10 Demand etc., were being conducted under the project which benefited Total 545 patients availed the free clinical services in the TI centre Okhla

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILEMEDICAL VAN (BHIWADI, RAJASTHAN)



In the month of November 2023, 738 beneficiaries have been benefited in 15 health check-up camps with free diagnostic care and medicine distribution. The PHDFWF-Jaquar mobile medical van has been providing health care services in five adopted villages of Jaquar in Bhiwadi, Rajasthan.

PHDFWF- JAQUAR FOUNDATION MOBILE MEDICAL VAN (KHAROI, GUJARAT)



Under the project, 1077 patients were benefited from 45 free health check-up camps in month of November 2023. The PHDFWF-Jaquar mobile medical van has been providing health care services in adopted villages of Jaquar in Kharoi, Gujarat, including free diagnostic care and medicine distribution.

PHDFWF-SMPF MOBILE MEDICAL VAN



During November 2023, 1199 residents from the local community accessed complimentary healthcare services through 17 free health check-up camps held in the resettlement areas of Delhi/NCR. The PHDFWF-SMPF mobile medical van has been delivering diagnostic services, doctor consultations, medical tests, and medications to underprivileged communities as part of the project.

PHDFWF-JAQUAR-ROTARY PREMIER MOBILE MEDICAL VAN



PHDFWF-Jaquar -Rotary Premier Mobile Medical Van has been delivering free health care services to children and needy on regular basis. 841 children were being examined by conducting 14 free health check-up camps in the month of November 2023 under the project. This van has also been providing free mobile health care to the abandoned children living in 101 children's homes in Delhi and also to the old aged home in Rohini and Gurugram.

PHDFWF- IAI DENTAL AND EYE MOBILE VAN



The PHDFWF-IAI Eye & Dental mobile medical van has been tending to underserved patients through the arrangement of cost-free eye and dental check-up events. These camps encompass dental examinations, scaling, fillings, diagnostic treatments, the provision of free medications, spectacles, and more as part of the initiative. In November 2023, a total of 1290 patients received diagnoses through 10 such free eye and dental camps.
