Aikido is basically a modern Japanese martial art that practitioners could use to defend themselves while also protecting their attackers from injury. PHDFWF-HSIL NEW SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, ALLA MOHALLA, OKHLA



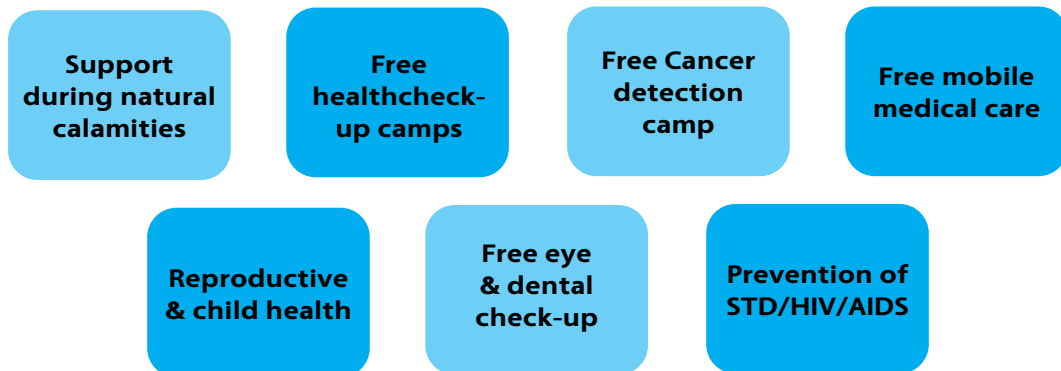

INAUGURATION OF NEW MOBILE MEDICAL VAN IN BHACHAU, GUJARAT



PHD Family Welfare Foundation with financial support from Jaquar Foundation has inaugurated its 7th Mobile Medical Van in Bhachau, Gujarat in the presence of senior officials of Jaquar Group and PHDFWF. This van will conduct free general health check-up camps and serve the downtrodden people of Bhachau and nearby areas.

PHDFWF-DSACS TARGET INTERVENTION PROJECT ON HIV/AIDS AND ITS COMMUNITY EVENT



The Target Intervention Project (TI) has been providing various Health/RCH Services to industrial and migrant workers with the financial support from Delhi State AIDs Control Society (DSACS) since 2003 in resettlement areas of Okhla. In this year, 2908 ICTC, 1019 RPR, 2729 RMC, 346 PT, 41 STI, 30 DIC, 51 Demand Generation meetings, 45 review meetings, 189 syphilis and 594 clinical foot falls were conducted under the program. Counselling of STD patients, HRGs are being done through teleconference by the doctors on a regular basis. PHDFWF organized a Community Event on October 21, 2021 at Tekhand village, Okhla under the target intervention project on prevention of HIV/AIDS. More than 100 HRGs and local community members attended and benefitted from the programme.

PHDFWF DIFFERENT MOBILE MEDICAL VANS

PHD Family Welfare Foundation with financial assistance from its different donors are providing healthcare facilities to the needy at their doorsteps since 1996. The health check-up camps are being organized in different resettlement colonies of Delhi/NCR, rural villages of Gurugram, Bhiwadi and Gujarat. Since inception till August 2021, a total of 7,536 health camps and 13,98,132 patients benefitted from these camps.
