## **ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION**

**PHD Family Welfare Foundation** was set up by the PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry 38 years ago in the year 1986 as a charitable trust. The prime reason for establishing this foundation was to reach out to the poor and downtrodden and to fulfil the social commitments of PHDCCI towards the upliftment of underprivileged families.

The PHD Family Welfare Foundation (PHDFWF) a registered non-profit organization was promoted by the PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry more than three decades ago. PHDFWF was registered in November, 1986, as a Charitable Trust under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882. It is also registered under 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and FCRA promoted by the PHD Chamber for executing its family welfare programmes. The main focus areas of family welfare foundation are health care, skill development training, education, support & care for especially abled people, sanitation facilities for girls in schools, rehabilitation & relief camps during natural disasters and self-defence training for women etc. which are basically concentrates on these fundamental areas knowing that this is a need of all marginalized communities of our country.

Family Welfare Foundation has been serving through health care projects by delivering healthcare services through 11 mobile medical vans and target intervention project and benefitted more than 17 lakhs beneficiaries in Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Delhi NCR.

The PHDFWF has currently 26 skill development units in the states like Odisha, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Haryana and Delhi NCR. These skill development projects are based on providing need-based skills enhancement training on various vocations like Tailoring, Beauty Culture, Computer Education, Mobile repairing, Electrician, Retails Management, Culinary, tutorial classes including awareness generation programme, exposure visits and programme for women and youth empowerment in all the skill development centers. More than 53 thousand beneficiaries have benefited under the skills development projects. which will lead our beneficiaries to make them self-reliant.

PHD Family Welfare Foundation has also dedicatedly supported the needy beneficiaries, migrants' labourers, destitute children and underprivileged communities by providing monthly ration, dry food packets, masks, conducting health checkup camps and awareness generation camps during covid pandemic.

## **GEOGRAPHICAL AREA OF OPERATION**

PHDFWF operates in resettlement areas and rural areas of Delhi NCR, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Assam, Odisha, Gujrat, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Punjab and any other regions in case of national calamities etc.

## VISION

Develop deprived communities in every aspect to provide quality social welfare services by strengthening the education health and skills with special focused to the women and youth empowerment for their sustainability with dignity in a holistic manner.

## THE OBJECTIVES OF THE FOUNDATION ARE

To engage in the preparation, development and execution of any programme of family welfare including family planning, health care, skill development, health education, population education and family life education.

- 1. To initiate, participate in or motivate, execute any programme of family welfare including any programme for social and economic welfare of the people directly and/or in collaboration with any other agency or agencies.
- 2. To organise meetings, conferences, seminars, workshops, training programmes, population education classes, health education relating to family welfare activities.
- 3. To motivate and involve the youth in the family welfare programme
- 4. To receive grants-in-aid from government, semi-government, public or international bodies for carrying out the objects of the Trust or as corpus money of the Trust.
