PHDFWF is enhancing education for underprivileged children. The organization offers free remedial classes at four centers and computer training courses at eighteen centers across Delhi-NCR, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Chhattisgarh, fostering holistic well-being of these children.

HEALTH CARE

PHDFWF is providing high-quality, free primary medical care to low-income and underprivileged groups. The Target Intervention Project focuses on preventing HIV/AIDS among high-risk groups across Delhi-NCR, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Chhattisgarh. PHDFWF operates medical vans, including specialized eye and dental vans, supported by organizations like DSACS, Jaquar Foundation, Imperial Auto Industries Ltd., Seth Madanlal Palriwala Foundation, Rotary Club of Delhi Premier, Sangneria Foundation for Health and Education Trust and AAOT.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT & VOCATIONAL TRAINING

PHDFWF is making a significant impact on communities by running 25 skill development centers, Pan India including Gujarat, Assam, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Haryana, and Delhi-NCR. These centers are trying to make youth skilled and employed through our various training projects and programs to give them marketable skills so they can easily get permanent employment for Sustainable Livelihood. Funding agencies include SMPF, Jaquar Foundation, Hindustan Tin Works, Kajaria Ceramics, Goyal MG Gases and WRG New Jersey USA.
