DISTRIBUTION OF STATIONERY MATERIAL TO THE UNDER-PRIVILEGED CHILDREN IN DELHI / NCR



Stationery material including pens, pencils, erasers, and other essential educational materials, were generously distributed to underprivileged children living in the Delhi/NCR region. This initiative aimed to support the educational needs of children from low-income families, ensuring they have the necessary tools to succeed in their studies.

PHDFWF is dedicated to improving education for underprivileged children by employing innovative, child-focused teaching approaches. The organization provides free remedial classes at four centers and computer training at eighteen centers across Delhi-NCR, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Chhattisgarh. Through these academic and computer programs, PHDFWF is committed to promoting both academic success and the overall development of these children.

HEALTH CARE

The PHD Family Welfare Foundation (PHDFWF) is dedicated to offering high-quality, free primary medical care to low-income and underserved populations who face challenges accessing healthcare due to geographic, economic, or infrastructural barriers. The Foundation's Target Intervention project aims to prevent HIV/AIDS among high-risk groups in Delhi-NCR, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Chhattisgarh. To extend their reach to the most remote areas, PHDFWF operates 11 mobile medical vans, including specialized eye and dental units, with support from organizations such as DSACS, Jaquar Foundation, Imperial Auto Industries Ltd, Seth Madanlal Palriwala Foundation, Rotary Club of Delhi Premier, and Sanganerla Foundation for Health and Education Trust, as well as AAOT.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT & VOCATIONAL TRAINING

The PHD Family Welfare Foundation (PHDFWF) is making a meaningful difference in communities across India by operating 25 skill development centers in states such as Gujarat, Assam, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Haryana, and the Delhi-NCR region. These centers aim to equip youth with the skills needed for sustainable livelihoods, enhancing their employability through various training programs. The Foundation's efforts are backed by funding from organizations like SMPF, Jaquar Foundation, Hindustan Tin Works, Kajaria Ceramics, Goyal MG Gases, WRG New Jersey USA, and other supporters, all dedicated to addressing community needs through these initiatives.
