## EDUCATION



PHDFWF is dedicated to improving education for underprivileged children by employing innovative, child-focused teaching approaches. The organization provides free remedial classes at four centers and computer training at eighteen centers across Delhi-NCR, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Chhattisgarh.

## HEALTH CARE



PHDFWF offers high-quality, free primary medical care to low-income and underserved population who face challenges accessing healthcare due to geographic, economic, or infrastructural barriers. The Foundation's Target Intervention project aims to prevent HIV/AIDS among high-risk groups in Delhi-NCR, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Chhattisgarh. PHDFWF is operating 11 mobile medical vans, including specialized eye and dental units, with support from organizations such as DSACS, Jaquar Foundation, Imperial Auto Industries Ltd., Seth Madanlal Palriwala Foundation, Rotary Club of Delhi Premier, and Sanganer Foundation for Health and Education Trust, as well as AAOT.

## SKILL DEVELOPMENT & VOCATIONAL TRAINING

PHDFWF is operating 25 skill development centers in states such as Gujarat, Assam, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Haryana, and the Delhi-NCR region. SMPF, Jaquar Foundation, Hindustan Tin Works, Kajaria Ceramics, Goyal MG Gases, and WRG New Jersey USA are providing financial support to these centres.
